**THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR (PROTECTION OF ABORIGINAL
TRIBES) (AMEENEMENT) REGULATION, 2002**

Promulgated by the President in the Forty ninth year of the Republic of India.

A Regulation further to amend the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 240 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following regulation made by him :-

Short title 1) i) This Regulation may be called the Andaman
and commencement and Nicobar Islands (Protection of
Aboriginal Tribes) (Amendment)
Regulation, 1998.

(ii) It shall come into force on such date as the
Lieutenant Governor may, by notification in
the Official Gazette, appoint.

Amendment 2) In Principal Regulation instead of the existing
of Section 8 provisions under the Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3)
of Section 8, the following shall be substituted:-

- 8) 1) Whoever, in contravention of the provision of
Section 6 acquires any interest in or any land or
carries on any trade or business, in a reserved
area shall be punishable with imprisonment for a
minimum period of one year extendable upto 2
years only and a fine of Rs. 2000/- extendable
upto Rs. 10,000/- and the interest so acquired
shall be disposed of in such manner as the
Lieutenant Governor may, after taking into
consideration the circumstances of the case direct.
- 3) Whoever in contravention of a Notification issued
under Section 7 enters a reserved area shall be
punishable with imprisonment for a minimum
period of one year extendable upto 2 years only
and a fine of Rs. 2000/- extendable upto Rs.
10,000/-.
- 3) Whoever, does anything in contravention of any of
the conditions or restriction subject to which a
pass has been granted to him under Section 7,
shall be punishable with imprisonment for a
minimum period of one year extendable upto 2
years only and a fine of Rs. 2000/- extendable
upto Rs. 10,000/-
