On the way while walking the Jarawas shown the spot where they had planted earlier the papaya seedlings and the fruits they reported were plucked not by them but by non-tribals as the papaya seedlings were planted on the roadside. Jarawas suggested to plant such seedlings in the interior forest.

8. Inspected the dispersed plantation of coconut, banana on the Spike Island and Lakra Lungta. By and large the scattered plantation is quite successful. This could be continued further in association with the Jarawas. Limited men could be engaged to help Jarawa in raising the dispersed plantation so that these plantations will bear the fruits for Jarawa in near future.

9. Dogs are not taken for the hunting expedition. On specific inquiry the Jarawas informed that dogs will not act as an aid but on the otherhand they may drive away their game (pig). The efforts of field officials to remove Dogs from Jarawa camps be continued.

10. After discussion with the field officials including the Police, it is felt that there is a need to incorporate amendments in the law to make the following an offence :

- (i) Giving foreign items including food cloth etc. ✓
- (ii) Collecting blood, hair, any body part, tissue and genetic material. ✓
- (iii) Photography / videography. ✓

A proposal shall be moved for amendment in A & N Islands (PAT) Regulation 1956. (content of the amendment is annexed to minutes). ✓
