3. The Chief Secretary welcomed the members of the High Powered Committee. He made a mention about the deliberations of the Expert Committee on Jarawas (Committee notified by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India) which met today i.e. 17.7.2002 at 11.AM at Raj Niwas. The protection of the Jarawas from the deleterious effects of the contact of the outsiders is a critical issue. There are "Pull & Push" factors operating in the Jarawa situation. Chief Secretary mentioned that pull factors for Jarawas may include alien items like food, cloth, medicines, tobacco etc. The Push factor may include possible scarcity of resources like drinking water etc. Chief Secretary urged that all out efforts are to made to prevent damaging effect on the Jarawas in accordance with the direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Kolkata.
