We have already proposed an amendment of section 8 for enhancement of the penalities for the offences committed by the non-tribals and sent to the Govt. of India vide this Administration's letter dated 28th November, 2002 at page 126/C, which is under consideration.

The quantum of penalities incorporated in the amendment now proposed is the same as in the earlier amendment. Accordingly a draft amendment notification has been prepared and placed opposite for perusal. If approved, the draft amendment may be referred to the Law Department for vetting.
