The following agenda points were discussed seriatim :-

1. Declaration of Andaman and Nicobar District as Hilly/ Difficult area for providing assistance under IAY.

Dr. R. Padmanabhan, Chief Secretary wanted to know whether the ceilling fixed by the Govt. of India on assistance for construction of houses under IAY is sufficient. He also wanted to examine whether the money from some other Poverty Alleviation scheme/Plan scheme could be diverted to IAY. He further wanted to know the minimum cost of house under IAY. Shri N.Biswas, AE(RD) informed that the cost of construction per house may come to R. 30,000/considering the hilly terrain and scattered area. The Committee approved declaration of both Districts i.e. the District of Andamans and the District of Nicobars as difficult area for sanctioning assistance under Indira Awas Yojana for construction of houses. In fact due to the phenominal cost of transportation involed in procuring building materials viz. cement, sand, CGI Sheets etc. from the mainland it was felt necessary to approach the Govt. of India for considering further raising of ceiling for construction of houses under IAY in these Islands.
