

Q.No.12.(b) What is the machinery/checks devised to ensure that the reservations made in favour of Scheduled Tribes are actually fulfilled?

Ans. Rosters are required to be maintained by the concerned departments dealing with appointment of Category 'C' and 'D' posts. Further, periodical returns from all such departments are obtained by the Directorate of Tribal Welfare to ensure that the reservations made in favour of the Scheduled Tribes are fulfilled.
