The Committee did not have any delebrations at Port Blair .It had discussion with Village Captains and officials of the Admn. at Car Nicobar on 3rd Feb. 95. The report of the Study Group pertaining to this Admn. is at F/A. The discussions held with village Captains were a closed door meetings where no officials of the Admn. were invited /allowed. The points raised by the Capitains are as under:-



- (a) Recognition may be given to the Tribal Council by Govt.
- (b) Executive Powers and Powers of Planning should be given to the Council.
- (c) No Govt. interference in the functioning of the Council .
