The Committee on the Welfare of SCs/STs (Study Group) were informed that there is no formal Welfare Association of SC/ST employees on Andamand Nicobar Islands Forest Planatation Development Corporation Ltd due to poor representation of SC/ST employees in the organisation. The Committee met some of the representatives of A&N IFDC Ltd from 1300 hrs to 1400 hrs and the Management of the Commpany from 1400 hrs to 1500 hrs at Port Blair. The Complaints/Grievances relating to SCs and STs as put forther by the representatives and the clarification made by the Management of A&N IFPDC Ltd are as under.

COMPLAINTS/GRIEVANCES AND CLARIFICATIONS

- Most of the SC/ST employees were recruited on "Daily-wage" basis.,
- 2. Some of the daily-wage employees who were working over 10 years had not been regularised.
- The temporary employees were not being paid adequately. It was demanded that their pay may be increased.
