

SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Regarding Socio-economic Development of GCs/STs it was stated that the Bank had specifically not adopted any village/cluster predominantly inhabited by SC/ST people for their economic development. However, the bank had alloted more than 7000 villages under Service Area Approach wherein the responsibility of catering to the credit need of the villagers was by the Bank. These villages also included the villages having predominance of SC/ST people.
