Sir,

I am to say that the study Group-I of Parliamentary Committee on Welfare of SCs and STs during its visit to the A & N Islands from 1st to 5th Feb., 1995 visited Car Nicobar on 3rd Feb., 1995 and had a meeting with the village Captains of Car Nicobar Island. During the discussion, the village Captains raised the following demand (s) concerning your department.

1. Recognition may be given to the Tribal Council by Govt.
2. Executive Powers and Powers of Planning should be given to the Council.
3. No Govt. interference in the functioning of the Council.

The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, has directed that a consolidated reply of the Admn. on the demand should be finalised and sent to the Lok Sabha Secretariat, New Delhi, latest by 31st May 1995.

You are, therefore, requested to kindly furnish your comments on the above demand latest by 29th May, 1995 so that the Administration can send a consolidated report to the Lok Sabha Secretariat, New Delhi, well in time.

This may kindly be treated as 'MOST IMMEDIATE'.
