

4. The sub-centre are located one each at village like Kenyuka, Small Lapathy, Arong, Sawai and Kakana.

A centre an average covers 2 to 3 villages and around 3,300 population. The sub-centres are manned by trained ANMs and are visited by Medical Officers from Civil Hospital, Car Nicobar regularly.

At the sub-centres, antenatal clinics, immunisation clinics are conducted weekly and day to day OPD are conducted. The ANMs visit villages under their respective sub-centres and provide various services at door steps.

5. For control of communicable diseases, adequate staff under different national Programmes like, National Malaria Eradication Programme, National Leprosy Eradication Programme, National Tuberculosis Control Programme, National Programme for Control of Blindness have been positioned and they carryout their day to day activities under different programmes.

6. One Homoeo Dispensary with a qualified Homoeo Physician also functions at Car Nicobar.

7. The present medical facilities are found to be adequate and effective which is evident from some of the important Health indices. These health indices are favourable when compared to all India norms.
