The Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) are requested kindly to make necessary arrangements for rail reservations etc., in the First Class (Lower Berths) and or First/Second Class AC Sleepers for the Members and Officers for all rail journeys as per their requirements which will be communicated to the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) in due course.


11. Necessary instructions may also please be issued to the Railway Booking Office at Parliament House to issue tickets to the Officers accompanying the Committee.

12. The dispersal of the Committee is at Madras on 7 February, 1995. The reservations required for Members and Officers after dispersal of the Committee at Madras will be intimated to the Station authorities at Madras who may be instructed to provide such rail reservations as may be required at short notice.

13. The Indian Airlines are also requested to make various air reservations required in connection with the tour of the Study Group the details of which would be communicated shortly.

It will be noted from the tour programme that Study Group I will also be holding informal discussions with the officers of the Bank/Undertakings at various places to be visited by the Study Group. The Ministries concerned are, therefore, requested to issue instructions to Bank/Public Undertakings and all other concerned that these discussions should be of a confidential nature and that it shall not be permissible for the participants in the discussions or any one who may have access to its proceedings to communicate, directly or indirectly, to the Press or any unauthorised persons any information regarding its proceedings.
