We have initiated action for implementation of the programmes included in the schemes Construction of staff quarters for ITDP staffs at Car-Nicobar has been taken up-The estimate for construction of a Nicobarese Guest House at Sotuh Point, Port Blair has been submitted by the APWD and the same is under consideration of the Administration. The land for construction of the Nicobarese Guest House will be handed over to the APWD by the by the representative of Eribal Council, Car-Micobar shortly, as confirmed by the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobars. A proposal for creation of a post o f Statistical A ssistant , a HGC and a Daftry for the office of the Project Officer, ITDP , Car Nicobar has been submitted. The Area Manager , Andaman and Nicobar Consultancy Centre, Port Blair (A Govt. Enterprise) has been requested to work out the details for taking up evaluation studies of the Tribal sub-Plan.
