Please refer to the letter No-1-532/88-TW dated 29 th sept, '88 from the Director of tribal welfare Andaman and Nicobar Administration Port Blair together with its enclosures addressed to the undersigned endressing copy to you regarding allotment of funds to Scheduled castes and Scheduled tribes.

You are aware of the fact that the coconut development Board has not placed any fund at the disposal of this department for the implementation of coconut development scheme or for ^{diversion} ~~division~~ or allotment of the same for the benefit of Scheduled castes and scheduled tribes. The scheme under coconut development board in this Territory is implemented by the Deputy Director of your Board stationed at Port Blair. So this department is not in a position to take the desired action in the matter. The only work entrusted to this department is to recommend the cases of the individual coconut growers to your local office for sanction of subsidy. So far no tribal has come forward to avail the assistance of getting subsidy from the coconut development board for raising coconut plantation. However, efforts are being made to convince the tribals to avail themselves of the assistance being provided by the coconut development board.
