

15. Moving figures on the line of Calcutta Durga Puja to be organised this time. The Hon'ble Lt. Governor desired that figures depicting battle of Aberdeen, tribals shooting with arrows or similar type of designs should be attempted to give a fresh look to the Festival.

(Action by Suptd. Engineer (Electricity)).

16. Mime show, Magic show, drama etc., will be arranged through the Song and Drama Division. The artists will be provided lodging, boarding and transport but no remuneration will be paid to them. Transport between Port Blair and mainland will be provided, if it is not agreed to by the Song and Drama Division.

(Action by Director (IP&T)).

17. A good Horticulture garden in the Festival premises will be put up with good decorative flowers. Sale of good varieties of seeds from the stall of the Agriculture Department will be arranged.

(Action by Director (Agriculture))

18. The officials present in the meeting were of the opinion that good and attractive prizes should be given to the winners of different competitions. The number of prizes should also be increased this time.

(Action by PS to CS).

20. Tableaux of the 26th January '96 (Republic Day) should be preserved for displaying on the sides of the road leading to the ITF. Haphazard display of tableaux should be avoided.

(Action by all Tableaux displaying Department/ IGP).

21. Adequate fire fighting, sprinkling of water including first aid facilities would be organised during the festival to meet any type of unforeseen eventualities.

(Action by IGP/ Director of Health Services).

22. A suitable logo will be designed and got approved for the festival.

(Action by Director IP&T)

23. In order to avoid any dislocation of work during the period of the visit of the VVIP, it was felt that security passes would be issued.

At the end, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor desired that the participating departments should not only come up with the routine display but should come up with new innovative ideas to make their stalls more informative and attractive. All departments are to participate as was done during the last year. He hoped that there will be timely co-ordination to make the festival a grand success.
