

catalogue entry fee would be required to be paid. Thus, the total expenditure would be Rs.3,21,600/. The expenditure would be borne by the Directorate of Industries. Director (Industries) may take necessary approval/sanction therefor.

4. Secretary (IPT) pointed out that the theme for this year primarily relates to Industries Department and therefore, the Department should make proper plans to present the best possible display in the section of Small Scale Industries. Director (Industries) should also seek participation of the private sector in the Fair. Director of Industries would arrange to select only good quality items and handicrafts for display and sale, including souvenir items, during the Fair. Director of Agriculture would also take steps to select suitable items for display and sale keeping in mind the overall promotion of small scale industries during the Fair in consultation with Director of Industries. Director of Tribal Welfare would display the tribal artifacts, handicrafts apart from laminations displaying various aspects of tribal life. He would also consider selecting some tribal handicrafts for sale.

5. Forest Department intimated that a good number of items were returned unsold last year and there was also no sufficient space for storage. It was decided that the Department should select really good items for display and sale. It was agreed that storage facilities would be made so that the items can be properly stored. Director of Fisheries mentioned that he would be able to send some laminations of ornamental and other fishes for display only. President, Andaman Chamber of Commerce and Industries agreed to display decorated plywood and marketing the same as a part of small scale industry promotion.

6. Director of IPT would ensure that the films on tourism, marine life, tourism festival and tribal life are regularly screened at the Fair. Director of Tribal Welfare would make efforts to get a copy of the film produced by Doordarshan on tribal welfare and get it screened.

(Action: DIPT/DTW/RC)

7. Director of IPT would also make available suitable brochures and leaflets for the Fair. He would also make available suitable laminations for display during the Fair.

8. ANIIDCO would make available suitable maps, charts, etc., for display and also for sales. Some charts or brochures on industrial policy and incentives may also be prepared and displayed.
