PROPOSED POINTS FO DISCUSSION

- 1. Theme for the Festival including Fixation of Stall rent last year it was 1500 including electricity Charges.
- 2. Thrust areas in the Exhibition and priorities for allotment.
- 3. Erection and no. of Stall & sketch last year 100 stalls were made. This year the requirement could be more hence at least 10 more stalls will be required.
- 4. Proposed events to be decided on the pattern of previous ITF and any special event to be included.
- 5. Proposed cultural events to be undertaken and the coordination from the Andaman Chamber of Commerce.
- 6. Events to be organised outside Port Blair.
- 7. Organisation of special camps in outer islands and activities there in.
- 8. Stalls to be made available 20 days ahead.
- 9. Display of colour full crakers/ ammunation by Navy including display of ships in between Ross Island and Aberdeen Jetty.
- 10. Beautification of the Exhibition ground.
- 11. Regular supply of water by Municipal Council including maintenance of Hygene and cleanliness of the area.
- Vendors to be provided a free space outside the exhibition but with in the close proximaty of the ground.
- Painting of buildings/ decoration on the way from DC Office to the Exhibition ground by house owners / concerned departments.
- 14. Special bus schedule during ten day festival inorder to facilitate the public to witness the event in large number. Similarly the boat schedule will also be required to be synchronised by Director of Transport and Director Shipping Services, A&N Administration.
- 15. Illumination towards the approach & also outside the 'ITF.
- 16. Participation of mainland tourist corporations/ department.
- 17. Nicobari handicraft & participation of Nicobar including sale of handicraft to the tourist.
- 18. Any projections other than the allotted space to be discussed.
- 19. Requirements of electricity supply for the stalls.
- 20. Since high dignatory is expected to inaugurate the Exhibition, CID Branch of the Police department will issue identity cards to the Stall owners and volunteers and to the working staff at the time of inauguration.
