At the outset, The Commissioner - Cum-Secretary (IP&T) welcomed the participants and informed that like in previous years, this year too, Island Tourism Festival, 98 would be celebrated in a grand way. It was mentioned that the ITF-97 was held from 20-12-1997 to 5.1.1998 at Port Blair and upto 10.1.1998 at outer islands. Director (IP&T) informed that after examining the tourist arrival data over the years, it was decided by hon'ble Lt. Governor that the festival should be held in mid November. This issue was discussed at length. Conservator of Forests, Director of Shipping and Chief Engineer pointed out that during this period North-East monsoon would be active and would not be suitable for organising the festival due to bad weather. Director of Education was also of the view that the troups of South Zone and East Zone would not be available during this period due to the Children's Day celebration at New Delhi and, it is also not possible to divert full attention for the Island

Tourism Festival during November as children would be busy in the Children's Day. He also opined that the festival should be organised some where in the month of December '98. The
