

6. JET AIRWAYS

It has been decided that Jet Airways who has a direct role in promoting tourism in the islands may be requested to participate in IITF'99 by putting up their counter in A & N Pavilion.

7. PRIVATE PARTICIPANTS

The Director of Industries should ensure that sufficient private entrepreneurs are involve in the exhibition. The private participants will make their own arrangements for accommodation and transportation in New Delhi, due to limited infrastructure available with the Administration.

8. ANDAMAN DAY

Secretary(IP&T) asked the Director of Education to make the preparation well in advance to send the troupe for presenting programmes in Andaman Day celebrations in New Delhi. She told that the artists should mainly consist of children, than adults. She also told that repetition of programmes presented earlier should be avoided. The Director of Education has also been asked to appoint a coordinator for this. The children (artists) before deputed should be given proper training / rehearsals of the programmes to be presented.

9. CONFIRMATION

It has been decided that the Departments should confirm in writing to the Director(IP&T) about their participation with details of exhibits, space requirement etc. by 30/7/99

10. DEPUTATION OF STAFF

It has been decided that the participating Department should ensure deputation of sufficient number of competent staff. They should leave for mainland with the exhibits latest by 1/11/99, so that they can also be present at the final stage of fabrication of the pavilion and interior decorations.
