

ANNEXURE-A

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ORGANISATION OF BIHARAT DARSHAN

1. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTING THE PARTICIPANTS FOR
BHARAT DARSHAN

- a) This scheme is formulated to offer an opportunity to the tribal and women social workers weaker section of the society of A&N Islands to acquaint themselves with the social, cultural, industrial and scientific development on the mainland (India).
- b) The participants must be capable to absorb new ideas so that they may apply these ideas for the betterment of the life style for themselves and also spread to their neighbors to adopt the same with a view of uplift the economic condition of the society on their return from tour and ability to withstand the hazards of the long journey and climate.
- c) While selecting the participants care should be taken that the social worker/tribal already sponsored and availed the benefit during earlier years are not included in the team again.
- (d) Opportunity may be given to the Social Workers of different localities of Middle and North Andamans and also in the Nicobar groups of Islands.
- (e) The woken social workers should be of the weaker section of the society and their income should not be more than Rs.11,000/- per annum (Below poverty line).
- (f) While selecting it should be kept in mind that the women are atleast 84th pass because after returning they are supposed to educate their colleagues about the development of mainland.
- (g) In order to draw the departmental advance after calculating the required amount, the names of the candidate should be furnished to the Directorate of IP&T within one month so that tour could be undertaken at the earliest.
- (h) The names of the proposed women social workers/tribals for the tour should reach to the Director of IP&T for placing before the committee for final selection of the participation.
