

(d) Service Organisations which could deal with -

- i) Collection of wastes and conversion into fertilizers
- ii) Mid-day milk & snacks supplies

(e) Artificial Limb Centre for the physically handicapped,

(f) Formation of sanitary marts on a turnkey basis for supply & installation of sanitary equipments as also maintain them, if required. This would be an ideal scheme for the Safai Karmachari Corpn.

(g) Scavenging by mechanised methods.

This list is, by no means, exhaustive and any project could be thought of keeping in view the local requirement, infrastructure and the type of beneficiaries available.

- 2.2. A certain amount of funds should be set aside by apex Corps. for imparting free training to beneficiaries participating in the group scheme.

3.0. NGOs

Financing through NGOs must be stepped up. Guarantees only in the form of a letter should suffice. The maximum loan to an NGO is to be Rs.5 lakhs and loans to individuals from the NGOs should not exceed Rs.10,000/- for the time being. List of NGOs who have been selected by the Ministry, & R.K.Mission etc. can be obtained for guidance.
