- (A) Whether thousands of Tribals and Dalits converted to Buddhism at a massive gathering in Bombay on 27-05-2007 on the 50th year of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's conversion.
- (B)If so, the cases of conversions to Buddhism taken place during each of the last three years and in current year till date, State/Union Territory-wise;
- (C)Whether after embracing Buddhism, do they get some benefit reservation;
- (D) Whether some parties are gaining political benefit to increase the number in their favour;
- (E) The details of guidelines for conversion; and
- (F) The steps taken/propose to be taken to check misuse of conversion?
