Women Police have also been posted in the Police Station to take care of the women / children victims of the incidents during the course of investigation of the case (.) Part (d) The briefings to the Local Police Staff and making them aware of the legal provisions have sensitized Policemen to the enormity of the incidents (.) No community has been notified as SCs in this UT (.) There are only Scheduled Tribes (.) Since there are certain restrictions to the entry of nontribal in the tribal reserve areas, the chances of such instances taking place in those areas are minimal (.)
