



(a).	Increase incidents of atrocities on SCs, STs and weaker sections particularly on women and girls in various parts of the country	There is no increase in such cases in this U.T.

Supplementary:

1. A case crime No.822/02 U/s.451/354 IPC read with section 3(1)(xi) SC & ST(POA) Act, 1989 was registered at PS Aberdeen on 17/8/02 in which a tribal girl Miss Lafa aged 17 years R/o Tirur forest was molested by one M.Raju S/o.Muniyandi, 32 yrs R/o. Nayagaon, in G.B.Pant Hospital at Special Ward No.7. The accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody. After the completion of investigation, the case was chargesheeted which is pending trial in the court. This is an isolated incident and not because of any ill hatred feeling for tribals.
2. Another case crime No.417/02 dated 5/5/02 U/s.332/504 IPC was registered at PS Aberdeen on the complaint of a Lady Home Guard No.179 Sandhya Ray against ASI Annadurai of Police Marine Force unit of A&N Police. The accused ASI was arrested and is under suspension. The case has been chargesheeted and sent to court for trial. A departmental enquiry has also been initiated against the accused ASI.
3. However a Rape case u/s 376/344/292/506 IPC has been registered in PS Car Nicobar. Vide Cr. No.92/2002 dated 28/9/2002 and case is still under investigation.
