
I am directed to say that Dr. C. Narayana Reddy and Shri C. Ramachandraiah, MPs, had tabled the above mentioned Question in the Rajya Sabha, for answer on 3.3.2003, which had sought the following information:-

- (a) whether the Government are aware that in tribal areas like in Madhya Pradesh women are sold publicly by way of punishment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government propose to deal with it without detriment to the sentiments of the tribals?
