(D) IF SO, THE DETAILS THEREOF; STATE-WISE?

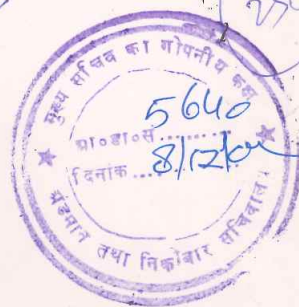
