May please refer to Rajya Sabha calling attention notice given by Dr. Dasari Narayana Rao, MP under rules 180 of the Rules of procedure and conduct of business received vide Fax message dated 12/11/2002 at page 41/C (PUC) of the Deputy Secretary (CSR), Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi. The text of notice is reproduced below:

"Increasing incidents of atrocities on SCs, STs, Weaker sections like Women etc. in various parts of the Country".

As the notice relates to atrocities on SCs, STs, Weaker sections like Women etc., it was referred to IGP to furnish the requisite information. The Dy.SP (HQ) of the office of the IGP has furnished the information vide page 42/C. In reply to the notice, he has stated that there is no increase in such cases in the UT. Accordingly we may answer.

Further he has furnished supplementary information in respect of three cases registered by the Police. Of the three cases, one relates to molestation of one Jarawa tribal girl, the second and third one relates to atrocity on women (non-tribal).

So far as the supplementary information furnished by Police Department is concerned, we may just furnish the number of cases registered by the Police, but not full details. Accordingly a draft reply is put up for approval please.
