1. **No. & Name of Scheme** : **(FOUR) Ship Repair facilities at Nicobar District (12)**

2. **Objectives** :

In order to provide accommodation for departmental staff who are posted in tribal areas, it is proposed to construct residential quarters at these areas like Car Nicobar, Nancowry and Campbell Bay and it is also proposed to set up infrastructural/repair facilities at outer ports of tribal areas like Car Nicobar, Nancowry etc. so that vessels/boats stationed and operated from there can be repaired/maintained easily.
