- (c) A scheme to increase the population of wild pig in the Shompen areas of Great Nicobar and Jarawa areas in Andaman Islands. A scheme can be formulated as suggested in the Master Plan for Welfare of Primitive Tribes.
- (d) Provision of veterinary sub centre Veterinary services could be made available to all villages of tribal area (Nicobars).

3. FISHERIES :-

A scheme to upgrade the fishing techniques among the primitive tribes to be included.

4. FORESTRY:-

- (a) A scheme to raise the coastal plantations including raising of mangroves to prevent the sea erosion in tribal areas of Nicobars and at Dugong Creek, South Bay in Little Andaman, Andamanese settlement at Strait Island.
- (b) Raising of bamboo, cane, etc., near the primitive tribe settlement of Andamanese and Onges.

5. CO-OPERATION:-

A scheme to provide financial assistance to the tribal Co-operative Societies including that of primitive tribes i.e. Onges in Andamans.

6. PORTS & LIGHT HOUSES :-

The request of tribal people for navigational aids in all the ports, the sea wall to prevent sea erosion in Nicobar Islands and suggestion of DC \prime
