Since the recommendations of the Committee go beyond the construction of Andaman Trunk Road, the matter is to be organised into a separate file.

(36) CC held a meeting with Secretary (Tribal Welfare), and CCF, D.C., representative of IGP, / representative of PE on 3-7-82 on the subject. A draft letter containing our comments is prepared for CC's approval in the light of the above discussion. The number of trips / contacts with Jarawas in 1981 has to be checked.
