Kindly refer to the correspondence relating with
your signal No.U-13015/17/82-ANL dated the 11th February
1983 regarding construction of AT road beyond 27 KMS
in South Andaman.

As desired, 5 copies of the map showing the
existing river/nallah courses, the alignment and the
shift suggested towards east in one reach are enclosed.

The survey is required to be done over 6 KMS
of thick forest area. I am advised by our PWD that
working conditions will be very difficult because of
the dense forests and Jarawas and, therefore, it will
take at least 6 months of fair season to complete
the survey. As we have got only 3 months of fair
season during this year, about 50% of the work will
be completed during this year and the rest will be
completed during the next fair season in 1984.
