(C). Likely cost of survey between 45-87 Kms. along fresh alignments suggested by Committee of Anthropologists and time expected to be taken for it.

Technical feasibility of this alignment may have to be studied in detail. However, for carrying out survey for this 41 Kms of road, minimum three working seasons will be required and the approximate cost of survey will be Rs. 4 lakhs. The Administration has already communicated the views regarding construction of road along the alignment in their letter No. 1-324/82-TW dated 5th July, 1982. From this it will be seen that the cost of 41 Kms. new construction will be about Rs. 3.5 crores. With the resources available in A.P.W.D. it may take about 8 years for construction of additional length of the road. This may also need procurement of additional machineries, such as bulldozers, trucks and road rollers.
