I am directed to say that a meeting will be held on 10.10.83 at 2.30 PM under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary in his office Chamber in the Secretariat to discuss the following points in connection with the resumption of construction of Andaman Trunk road between 87 and 110 KM passing through Jarawa Territory.

Agenda

1. The declaration of the area along the entire length of the road both on the western and eastern side falling in the Jarawa Territory as Jarawa Reserve to the extent, wherever it is possible.
2. To make the A&N Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes Regulation), 1956 statutory.
3. To have only temporary labour camps during the construction phase of Andaman Trunk Road.
4. Orientation of Bush Police Force on Jarawa problem.
5. Banning of exploitation of forest in the area adjoining the Jarawa reserve.
6. Educating the people about the boundary of Jarawa reserve by putting sign board etc.
7. Appointment of an officer concerned and sensitive enough for monitoring implementation of the safe guards recommended by the Team of Anthropologists.
