

3. Regular contact with Jarawa :

The policy of maintaining regular contact with the Jarawas has been systematically pursued. The Jarawa Cell party under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner Andamans is making regular contacts by dropping gifts. The last contact was made in December, 1983. The contact party raised plantation in Flat Bay and Bluff Island and dropped gift articles, from time to time. The meeting concluded after a vote of thanks to the Chair.
