Lt. Governor explained that no team had gone to meet the Jarawa tribe without a representative of the A.S.I. He stated that it might not be a correct step to exclusively assign the responsibility for establishing contact with the Jarawa and close monitoring and implementation of the safeguards to A.S.I.

7. After discussions, it was agreed that a team should really be entrusted with these tasks in which the A.S.I. should be adequately represented. The Lt. Governor agreed to send a detailed note on the steps taken by the Administration in relation to resumption of the 87-110 kms Trunk Road and measures for promoting the interests of the Jarawa tribes.
