2. The request for sanction of more posts of Bush ^{Police} ~~Police~~ may be examined favourably and sufficient men posted at all strategic points so that non-tribals do not stray into tribal areas and expose themselves to uncalled for risks and so that tribals are allowed to have peaceful access to the site which may unavoidably happen to be on the eastern side of the road alignment and which may have been in use as their source of water.
3. The task envisaged at 2 above is very delicate and members of the Bush Police have to work with great tact. After sanction of more bush police posts as stated in para 2 above efforts be made to post experienced and reliable persons who have the necessary orientation.
4. A representative of C.E., BRO (Chief Engineer, Border Roads Organisation) may also be coopted as a member of the Watch Dog Committee.
