Sub:- Formulation of IXth Five year Tribal sub-Plan and Annual Tribal Sub-Plan in respect of Sector village and small scale Industries - regarding -

Sl.No.1(R) Page 1-31/Cor.

① The Director of Industries has furnished the <sup>following</sup> schemes in respect of Sector "Village and small scale Industries" for the IXth five year plan and Annual Tribal sub-plan for the year 1997-98.

1. Strengthening of Industries department.
2. Providing marketing assistance.
3. Advance training on mainland.
4. Motivation awardness programme
5. Modernisation of training centre.
6. Setting up industrial Estate.
7. Setting up of training cum Production in coir, rubber and cane at Katchal.

③ An outlay of Rs.311.54 lakhs is earmarked under flow of funds for the IXth five year plan which constitutes 5.7 % of the proposed UT Plan outlay of Rs.5478.59 lakhs. and an outlay of Rs.49.33 lakhs for the Annual Plan 1997-98, which constitutes 5.97% of the proposed UT plan outlay of Rs.825.22 lakhs.

③ Similarly an outlay of Rs. 5 lakhs is proposed to be invested from SCA for the IXth five year plan (1997-2002) and an outlay of Rs. 1 lakh for the Annual Plan 1997-98.

② Against the outlay of Rs.60.80 lakhs for the VIIIth five year plan an amount of Rs.59.88 lakhs is likely to be spent during the end of this financial year. Similarly against the outlay of Rs.10 lakhs proposed to be invested <sup>from SCA</sup> during the VIIIth Five year plan an amount of Rs. ~~3.67~~ 3.67 lakhs is anticipated to be spent at the end of the current financial year.

⑤ As per ANCON Report, it is recommended that more and more attention should be given towards motivational ~~competitions~~ among the tribal youths and also may organise product specific training programme and also to supply <sup>necessary</sup> many inputs to the tribals. *The Schemes Proposed by Director of Industries at Para 11/10 may please be Perused.*

⑥ In this connection it may be mentioned that we have not received the suggestion for inclusion of any schemes for the Welfare of Tribes from Deputy Commissioner Nicobar so-far.
