Through this scheme it is envisaged for deputing eligible candidates for advanced training in various skills in mainland besides arranging study tour of the coir, boat building, rubber and coconut based industries in the mainland for interested entrepreneurs and artisans. During the 9th FYP it is proposed to depute 6-10 tribal candidates on advance training and 5-10 tribal candidates on study tour, every year. Special efforts will be made to ensure participation of tribal women entrepreneurs in this programme and also primitive tribes of the territory such as Ongees, Andamanese, Shompens etc.
