

## CHAPTER IX

CONCLUSIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND ACTION PLANConclusions

1. There should be separate approach for each tribal group depending on their level of development both economic as well as cultural.
2. The literacy level of the tribals are abysmally low and they have hardly any concept regarding surplus economy and the ability to create any asset through income generating economic activity due to lack of proper training, motivation and assistance on long term basis.
3. The tribals are not in a position to sustain and maintain the assets given to them due to their poor socio-economic conditions.
4. The existing dole system has made the tribal people dependent on outside support.
5. All the schemes of the Administration implemented so far are mostly directed towards providing support to the tribal community rather than develop them economically and culturally. The support system of the Administration has created considerable effect on the materialistic life of the tribal people without making any perceptible impact on their cultural world.
