Allocation of fund under TSP/SCA recorded an overall increase during the last thirteen years or so and the lions share of the total fund allocation has been utilised for creation of infrastructural facilities only without giving much attention on family oriented schemes which is directly related with the welfare of the tribal family.  
Due to over emphasis on infrastructural development the directorates/departments related to this type of activities showed a better performance of utilisation of funds.
12. Due to lack of proper monitoring and evaluation, the schemes implemented by the Administration could create little impact on the socio-economic conditions of the tribal people.
13. A significant percentage of the tribals are still living below the poverty line and a major portion of the tribal population are still unemployed while some of them have got used to "daily wages thinking".
14. There is scope for introducing some location specific simple economic activities among the tribal people. However, successful implementation of the same requires to be provided with suitable forward as well as backward linkage support to the tribals on long-run basis apart from motivational support.
