motivated to participate and perform various cultural activities of their own. To this end, Administration may think of involving some dedicated social organisations.

2. The Onges may be gradually motivated in participating various kinds of simple economic activities including agriculture suitable to their own locality through consortium effort of all the directorates/ departments. The existing skill among the Onges for manufacture of handicraft items may be developed by imparting suitable training so that their products may be acceptable in the market on commercial basis. Such training programmes may be organised on cluster basis through NGO's/Voluntary organisations with sponsorship of concerned directorates/departments of the GOI.
3. In order to gradually induce the Onges towards a sustaining economy, the existing dole system should gradually phased out in a planned manner.
4. In order to reduce harmful effects that may be transferred to the Onges from the outsiders directly or indirectly, the flow of unwanted intruders is to be stopped.
