

the tribal areas so that the tribals are attracted towards such activities as a part of improving their economic status.

5. Directorate of Health Services

- a. Although the directorate has made several endeavour for creation of medical facilities in different tribal areas, it appears that the tribals are in general unaware about the basic health education such as personal hygiene, usage of drinking water, cleanliness etc. It is, therefore, recommended that the directorate may organise more and more health educational/awareness camps in various interior tribal areas so as to enlighten the tribals regarding the preventive care from various diseases.

6. Directorate of Industries

- a. In spite of low level of allocation of fund the Directorate has made appreciable effort towards creation of capital assets in the tribal areas and providing loan/subsidy and technical inputs to the tribal beneficiaries. However, inertness towards any entrepreneurial activities by the tribal population acts as a severe limiting factor for overall success of the schemes to the desired extent. It is, therefore, recommended that more and more attention should be given towards motivational campaigns among the tribal
