concerned directorates/departments of the Administration may provide all input support from their fund under TSP/SCA. However, it should be a continuous process and no one-shot measure would yield the desired result. It is felt that in addition to the respective directorates/departments of the Administration, some voluntary organisations/NGOs may be involved in the implementation process. These NGOs may be given the responsibility for constant monitoring and follow-up of the entire process after providing necessary training and other inputs to the tribal people by the Administration. For inducting the tribals to such economic activities the Administration may provide some positive incentives to those who will show interest in it or vice-versa. For example, except the people of a certain age group, all the able people may be influenced to undertake such activities by introducing some sort of disincentive measures in case they decline to join such programmes. This may initially create some stress in the community but in the long run the same may prove beneficial for them.
