

concerned directorates/departments of the Administration may provide all input support from their fund und .TSP/SCA. However, it should be a continuous process an no one-shot measure would yield the desired result, it is felt that in addition to the respective directorates/departments of the Administration, possesses voluntary organisations/NGOs may be involved in the implementation process. These NGOs may be given the responsibility for constant monitoring and follow-up a entire process after providing necessary training and other inputs to the tribal people by the Administration. For inducting the tribals to su economic activities the Administration may provide so positive incentives to those who will show interest it or vice-versa. For example, except the people of o age group, all the able people may be influenced undertake such activities by introducing some sort disincentive measures in case they decline to join su programmes. This may initially create some stress and the community but in the long run the same may beneficial for them.
