And whereas the rates are revised on six monthly basis

Now , therefore the Lt.Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands declares the following Minimum wages w.e.f 01-03-2011 across Six schedules of employments in addition to Govt Deptt/Offices/Industrial Establishments taking into account the Average All India Consumer Price Index for the period March 2010 to September 2010.
