

2. BEHATAR JEEVAN KI DORE (Economic Package). (Hindi, 15 mts).
Film is based on Govt. schemes for economic empowerment of SCs. This film gives information about the National Scheduled Caste Finance and Development Corporation and self-employment schemes for SCs.
3. A Film on Eradication of Scavenging (Hindi 15 mts). This film revolves round the central theme of removal of scavenging. The film is an attempt to present various measures taken for training, rehabilitation and self-employment of scavengers and their dependents.
4. Waqt Ki Pukar – is a film about the need of time i.e. conversion of dry latrine into wet latrine. Since eradication of scavenging depends mainly on conversion of dry latrines into wet latrines, an attempt has been made through this film to motivate people in this direction. The film gives detailed information as to how this could be done in a low budget.
5. A film on welfare of people working in leather industry – the film depicts the living conditions of people working in the leather industry and various efforts of Leather Technology Mission for development of leather industry.

MINORITY AND BACKWARD CLASSES

- S.No. 1. Maulana Azad Education Foundation. (Hindi, 15 mts).
This film aims at informing such potential individuals and organizational donors of the activities of the Foundation as also the acute need for corrective action in the educational imbalance of the target group vis-a-vis the rest of the Indian society, with a view to motivating them. A film on NMDFC is to make charitable donations.
2. This is a film about various measures undertaken for creating opportunities for self-employment for minorities and improving their economic condition. The film gives details of various schemes of financial assistance provided by National Minority Development and Finance Corporation at concessional rates.
 3. 'Bhore Ka Sapna' (Hindi, 15 mts) – is a documentary about opportunities for self employment of people belonging to Backward Classes. This film covers various loaning schemes of National Backward Classes Finance and Development Corporation. Procedures and formalities required to be completed for availing benefit of these schemes are also covered in the film.
 4. 'TARRAKI KI RAHEN' on Wakf Council and Wakf Board, Hindi, 23 mts each.
The Documentary includes the activities of Wakf Boards and Wakf Council as well. It gives details of loan assistance to degree, technical and madrasa systems. Vocational assistance is highlighted including the impact it has made on needy Muslim families by making them self-sufficient and the gradual change being ushered in the society. The activities of the Board of mass benefit like reservation of 1/3rd scholarships for women, merits-cum-means scholarships; pensions to Muslim widows; maintenance of mosques, Shrines, Schools and grave-yards will be highlighted.
