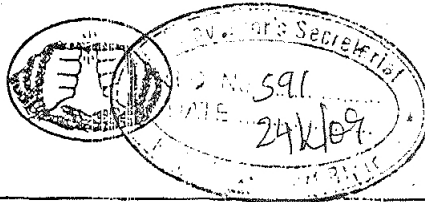

Sub: Whimsical and unlawful cessation of duty from Muster Roll of Sri Uttam Das S/O. Sri Baketal Das of 15 Radha Madhab Saha Lane, Kolkata-700007, a Scheduled Caste Casual worker, performing duty at Salt Lake Bhavan, in plot no.7 of D.P. Block, Sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700091, from April 1994 to June 2008

We have received a representation from the above named poor Scheduled Caste Casual daily rated worker, who was working under you in Muster Roll from the period April 1994 to June 2008 in different capacities, informing us that from July 1998 his name was suddenly removed from Muster Roll whimsically and unlawfully on the plea that the function which he was performing was contracted out and given to Contractor. Instead of performing duty directly under you in Muster Roll he was told to report to the contractor only for performing his duty, where he was serving from July 1998 till September 1998.

But from Middle of September 2008, all on a sudden, the said contractor is not allowing him to join his duty. As a result he has become jobless and not in a position to support his poor family including dependent aged parents as he has got no other means for livelihood. The poor Scheduled Caste family is on the verge of starvation in these hard days.

- Sri Uttam Das has represented his case several times before you for taking him back in your Muster Roll but the same has not yielded any fruitful result till date. He has even represented that some other daily rated casual worker who were much junior to him during his duties were allowed to perform duty in Muster Roll but he even being senior to them is debarred from the above opportunity.
