Director, Ministry of Tribal Welfare, New Delhi regarding mater-  
ials for parliamentary Committee on the Welfare of Schedule Caste  
and Schedule Tribes Atrocities of Schedule Caste and Schedule  
Tribes and pattern of social crime and also requested the  
following information;

1. Number of cases registered under the Protection  
of Civil Right Act 1955 during the last three yrs.
2. Number of cases registered under the Schedule Castes  
and the Schedule Tribes Prevention of Atrocities)  
Act, 1 989 together with the broad category of cases  
such as murder,hurt,rape, kindapping or abduction ,  
dacoity ,robbery ,arson etc in the last three yrs.
3. Number of cases yearwise in the last three yrs,  
where conviction under these two Acts have taken  
place.
4. The average time taken for securing conviction  
seperately under these Acts.
5. Number of special courts set up in the State to try  
offences under these two Acts.
6. Problems faced in expediting finalisation of these  
cases and bring down them to their local conclusion.

required information to this department for onward transmission
