I am directed to refer to your department letter No. 5-58/99-TW/393 dated 18th June, 2004 on the subject mentioned above.

2. It is observed that the number of cases pending with Police and Court at the end of year 2002 were shown as Nil cases and 1 cases respectively where as the number of cases brought forward during the year 2003 with police and court were shown as Nil and Nil cases respectively which do not tally. The number of cases pending with Police and Court at the end of a particular year and the number of cases brought forward with Police and Court at the beginning of next year should be the same.

4. It is, therefore, requested that the **revised statistical details** of cases registered by Police and Courts and their disposal under the Act for the calendar year **2003** may kindly be furnished to this Ministry urgently.
