(73) The PUC is the letter No.11016/1/2004-PCR (DESK) dated 23rd February, 2004 of Joint Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment regarding the Annual Report on the working of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 for the Calendar year ended 31st December, 2003 vide PUC the Govt. of India stated that the Govt. of India is required to co-ordinate the measures taken by the state Govt. for implementation of the provisions contained in the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and place a report on the table of each house of Parliament on the measures by itself and the state Govts in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 21(4) for the SCs & STs (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989. Further rule 18 of the SCs & STs (Prevention of Atrocities) Rule, 1995 provides that the state Govts are required to furnish before 31st March, a report of the Central Govt. about the measures under taken for implementing the provision of the Act various schemes / plans framed during the previous calendar year.

(74) In accordance with the above statutory provisions, the Govt. of India desires the state Govt. has to furnish the information in three parts viz.

(75) **Part - I:** Summary of measures taken by the UT Administration for implementation of the provisions contained in the section 21(4) of the SCs & STs (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989, viz legal aid, traveling and maintenance expenses economic & social rehabilitation, appointment of officers, setting up of committees at appropriate levels, special courts, periodical surveys, identification of areas. Subject to atrocities and other measures to ensure removal of atrocities.

(76) **Part - II:** Relevant statistical details of cases registered under SC & STs (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 and there disposal during the calendar year vide Annexure I & II.

(77) **Part - III:** Statistical information on details of expenditure incurred for implementation of the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 vide Annexure III & IV.

(78) The due date for the submission of the information was 31/03/2004, while the PUC is received by this Administration only on 15/04/2004.

(79) In this connection it is stated that the Police Department is concerned with Part II of the information giving relevant statistical details of cases registered and their disposal under the SCs & STs (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in Annexure II and Part III giving details of expenditure incurred for implementation of item Nos. 1 & 3 in Annexure IV. We may request the IGP to furnish the required information in the prescribed format framed by the Govt. of India, if approved.
